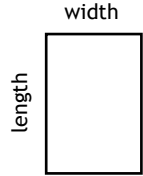

I/We have read and understand the requirements for entries into the Hannah Dustin Quilters Guild Annual Quilt Show, and understand that failure to comply may result in the elimination of my entry from the Show.

I/We further understand that the Hannah Dustin Quilters Guild and the Hudson Community Center will make every effort to insure that my/our quilted entry is returned in the same condition in which it was entered into the Show. However, **INSURANCE FOR THE QUILT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE OWNER**, and I/we agree not to hold the Hannah Dustin Quilters Guild responsible for damage, theft, loss, or other occurrences to my/our quilted entry that are beyond the normal care and attention given to such items during the exhibit. I/We also agree and understand that once the quilted entry is delivered for display, it will not be available for pick-up until 45 minutes after the close of the Show, or when the hall is cleared.

My/Our signature(s) also grants Hannah Dustin Quilters Guild the right to use any photograph taken of my/our quilt at the Show for publication, advertising, promotional use, or other printed or electronic materials as the Show Committee chooses.

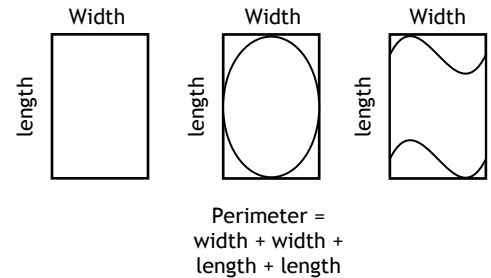
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ENTRY RULES AND GUIDELINES FOR EXHIBITION

- Active members of the Hannah Dustin Quilters Guild may enter quilts in the Quilt Show.
- All quilts, regardless of size, must have a 6” sleeve installed on the top of the back of the quilt. Quilts will NOT be accepted for display without a 6” sleeve.
- The Quilt Show will accept other quilted works such as clothing, handbags, or decorative items in the “Other” category. The submitting member may be asked to provide suitable display items for their entries.
- Quilts and other quilted works must be delivered in suitably sized paper or gift bags WITH HANDLES between the hours of 7 a.m. and 9 a.m. on the first morning of the Quilt Show. Late entries may be rejected.
- In the event that the number of quilts entered into the Show exceeds the available space, those having multiple entries may be asked to withdraw one or more entries.
- Challenge Quilt entries are subject to the rules and guidelines of the Challenge Committee in addition to the general rules above. Judging may occur before the actual Show dates and may require an additional drop-off and pick-up at a date, time, and place to be decided by the Challenge Quilt Committee.

DEFINITIONS

- Small Quilt:** Quilt with a perimeter of 120 inches or less.
Medium Quilt: Quilt with a perimeter greater than 120 inches but less than 280 inches.
Large Quilt: Quilt with a perimeter of 280 inches or more.
Youth Entry: A quilt entered by a Guild member on behalf of a young relative (under 18 years).
 All other rules and guidelines apply for entry and exhibition.
Other: Includes all 3-dimensional quilted items such as clothing, handbags, decorative items, 3D challenge, etc.



Perimeter: For a square or rectangular quilt: The combined measurement of all 4 exterior sides of a quilt. For a quilt that is not square or rectangular: The combined measurement of all 4 exterior sides of an imaginary square/rectangle that surrounds the quilt.

Quilt Show Entry Form

It’s that time of year again to submit entry forms for the annual Quilt Show on April 27 and 28, 2018. Please fill out one entry form per quilt. This includes the challenge quilts. **Please note that only the first page of the entry form needs to be submitted, with your signature.** Entry forms will be available at the meetings through March. You can hand-deliver entry forms to Janice Kagenski at a Guild meeting, or mail/email them to the address included on the entry form. The entry form will also be available on the Hannah Dustin website. All entry forms must be received by the March 16, 2018 deadline.

Again this year: Online submission of entry forms beginning in late December! There will be a link in the “For Our Members” area of the Hannah Dustin website (<http://hannahdustingq.org/>) which will bring up an online entry form. Please fill in all areas with the requested information and press the “Submit” button. If you have provided an email address a confirmation email including all the submitted information will be sent to you. You can also print the online entry form prior to pressing the “Submit” button. Please note, however, that due to formatting restrictions, up to 6 pages will be required. **If at all possible, please use the online entry form. It will greatly reduce the time I spend deciphering paper forms.**
